



**1. Proposed Textual Amendment – Corman Park-Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw – Internment Service Clarifications – Bylaw 16/17**

---

**Background:**

The purpose of this report is to propose a textual amendment to the Corman Park-Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw to replace the word internment with interment in any place it is found within the bylaw.

**Analysis:**

The issue we have in both the R.M. and Corman Park-Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaws is related to our definition for Internment Service. The word internment is related to prison, captivity, etc. and the word should actually be interment which relates to burial, cemeteries, etc. The actual definition for Internment Services in the District Zoning Bylaw is:

*Internment Service – means establishments primarily engaged in the permanent disposition of human remains through a variety of manners and shall include but is not limited to cemeteries, crematoriums, funeral homes and mausoleums.*

The wording in the definition shows there is an error in the word used.

A separate textual amendment is being considered for the R.M. of Corman Park Zoning Bylaw as part of the Industrial District amendments.

**District Planning Commission:**

The District Planning Commission (DPC) considered this textual amendment at their November 2, 2016 meeting. The DPC had no concerns and supported the recommendation to give First Reading of Bylaw 51/16 to replace the word “internment” to “interment” within the Zoning Bylaw.

This bylaw was missed from previous agendas, as such it requires a new number, Bylaw 16/17 from 51/16, as the year is now 2017. A new resolution from the DPC is not required since the intent and wording does not differ from what the DPC supported; R.M. Administration apologizes for the delay and inconvenience.

**Recommendation:**

*“That the R.M. Council support First Reading of Bylaw 16/17.”*



**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CORMAN PARK NO. 344**

**BYLAW 16/17**

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 23/10 known as the Corman Park-Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 23/10 as follows:

1. "Bylaw 23/10 is being amended by deleting "internment" and substituting "interment" where it appears in the following sections, subsections or clauses as the case may be:
  - a. Schedule C, section 3.11;
  - b. Schedule C, section 7;
  - c. Schedule C, section 8;
  - d. Schedule I, section 2.9;
  - e. Schedule L, section 2.9; and
  - f. Section 6."

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon receiving the approval of the Minister of Government Relations.
