

BYLAW NO. 12/09

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression:
 - a) "highway" means any public highway within the Municipality under the direction, control and management of the Municipality and "public highway" means a public highway as defined by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84;
 - b) "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to The Highway Traffic Act;
 - c) "parking" shall mean the standing of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a highway, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading, or in obedience to traffic regulations, traffic signs or signals, or the direction of a traffic officer or constable.
2. Subject to the provisions of Section 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 hereof the parking of motor vehicles is permitted on all highways.
3. Pursuant to Section 40 of The Highway Traffic Act, and this Bylaw, no persons shall stop or park a motor vehicle on any public highway, outside of a hamlet, within 30 metres of another motor vehicle stopped or parking on the opposite side of the highway.
4. No motor vehicle shall be parked on any highway with the engine running, unless the same is under the control of a licenced operator.
5. No motor vehicle used, designed or intended for the conveyance of inflammable, combustible, explosive or other dangerous materials, whether loaded or unloaded, shall be parked at any time upon a highway except for the sole purpose of, and only for the time necessary to receive or deliver orders.
6. Vehicles are prohibited from parking at any time on any portion of a highway or highways specified in Schedule A attached to and forming part of this Bylaw. Every area where parking is so prohibited shall be designated by the erection and maintenance therein of suitable signs or marker, clearly visible from the travelled portion of the highway, showing that parking in such area is prohibited.
7. No person shall park a motor vehicle at any time within any area where parking has been prohibited in according with Section 6.
8. No person shall deface, injure, destroy or remove any sign or marker erected in according with the provisions of this Bylaw.
9. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$80.00. A Voluntary payment in the reduced amount of \$20.00 shall be accepted if received within 14 days from the date of service of the Notice of Violation contained in Schedule B.

PROHIBITED PARKING LOCATIONS:

- a) Curve on the highway situated in SE 14/35/6/W3rd.
- b) On the highway adjacent to NW3-36-5-W3 and through SE/4/35/6/W3rd.
- c) On the East side of Wurtz Avenue located in the Industrial Park in the South Half of Section 14/38/5/W3rd.
- d) On the highway adjacent to W1/2-6-36-5-W3 and adjacent to and through W1/2-7-36-5-W3.
