

BYLAW NO. 67/98

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw;
 - a) “firearms” means a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, or any other thing by means of an explosive;
 - b) “Country Residential Subdivision” – means any area within the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 which under the provisions of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 Zoning Bylaw or the Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw zoned CR1, CR2, CR3, CR4, DCR4 or DCR5
 - c) “Commercial Subdivision” - means any area within the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 which under the provisions of the Rural Municipality of Corman Park No. 344 Zoning Bylaw or the Saskatoon Planning District Zoning Bylaw zoned C, M1, M2, REC, DC1, DM3, or DREC1.
2. Subject to Section 3 hereof, no person shall discharge any firearm within this Municipality.
3. This bylaw shall not apply where a firearm is discharged:
 - a) by any person on land, other than Country Residential Subdivision or Commercial Subdivision, or within five hundred (500) metres of such subdivision on which he is in actual occupation; or
 - b) on the said land by any member of his family or by any other person with his permission; or
 - c) during the open season by a holder of a license to hunt big game or game birds issued to him under The Wildlife Act; or
 - d) where Council has issued a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this Municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 1/67 is hereby repealed
