

## **Municipal Reserve Funding**

The R.M. has a fund that we refer to as the “Municipal Reserve” fund that comes from provincially mandated recreation fees taken when the subdivision of property occurs. The funds are available at Council’s discretion for projects that meet the provincial requirements, and are located on Municipal Reserve land. The requirements are relatively general, and are mostly related to capital expenditures for recreational type facilities, under which many facilities qualify, including playgrounds, community halls, outdoor rinks, and other structures, so long as it is located on municipally owned land.

If you and your organization would like to make an application to the R.M. of Corman Park for municipal reserve funding, a letter to Council outlining your proposal is required. The letter must state your project and provide any information that the Board deems would be important for consideration. This will include information on design, a budget and information on the usage of the facility. A minimum of two quotes must accompany your proposal along with information on any fundraising and/or community involvement that has been done. Please provide any other items that you think would be helpful for Council making a decision on providing funding.
