## Property Tax Updates

### PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES

Effective January 1, 2013 tax incentives (discounts and rebates) set by Municipalities will no longer apply to education property tax. The RM of Corman Park will continue to offer discounts on the current year municipal levy.

## Fire Insurance

Landowners are reminded it is unwise to burn in very windy, dry weather and always provide extensive fire guarding before a controlled burn. Failure to do so is a contravention of the Prairie and Forest Fires Act. It is important to obtain adequate fire insurance so

that you and your property are protected in case of a fire. The Municipality has seen fire bills exceed \$20,000. Please contact your insurance provider for rate information. It is recommended to have more than just basic fire coverage. For questions about fire fighting rates please contact our office

## New Custom Work Rates

The RM Public Works Department will be maintaining the many kilometers of roadway throughout the winter months. If you wish to have your private driveway graded you must be signed up at the RM office to receive this service. A sign deposit of \$10.50 will be required. Please note that custom work rates have increased effective January 1, 2013 as follows:

### CUSTOM WORK RATES

15 Minutes or less	\$50.00
16–30 Minutes	\$100.00
31–45 Minutes	\$150.00
1 Hour thereafter	\$200.00
Mowing	\$120.00/hour
	Minimum

Tuesday—Saturday  
Apr. 16—Sept. 29 8am to 7:30pm  
Sept. 30—Apr. 15 10am to 5pm

Note: During winter months the landfill will close if temperatures reach  $-40^{\circ}$

by municipal crews and all expenses incurred shall be borne solely by the responsible party.
